WE ARE LOOKING FOR students with a demonstrable interest in Eastern Europe, an excellent first degree, fluent German, at least basic knowledge of an East European language and proficient English. We are also interested in applicants who are involved in social and political work.

THE CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS is 14 June

2019. The graduate program begins in the winter semester and lasts four semesters.
