EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR JOURNALISTS

Our mission is:

- To promote cross-border cooperation between journalists from Germany and Armenia
- To initiate lasting journalistic networks on the subject of war reporting
- Raise awareness of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict and other conflicts in the Eastern Partnership countries

Your part in our project:

Would you like to carry out research on the topics of war and conflict, working together with colleagues and experts from Germany and Armenia, and publish your contributions in an English speaking, civic society environment? We put you in contact with relevant stake holders and NGOs from the partner countries and support you in your research through our contacts and networks. The **study trip to Yerevan/Armenia** will take place from **18.-24.11.2022**. We will gladly cover the costs for the flights (from Frankfurt), for the program as well as the hotel (in double rooms) and catering costs.

After your participation in the research trip, we expect to publish at least one journalistic contribution on the Armenian National Platform. Further publications in various media from your side are welcome.

Our project activities:

October 2022: A group of Armenian journalists visits Berlin to get to know German perspectives on the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict and benefit from experiences in other conflict regions, including Georgia and Ukraine.

November 2022: From 18-24.11.2022 the research trip to Yerevan/Armenia will take place, which is aimed at journalists from Germany

December 2022 The articles and outputs should be published in different kinds of media. We would greatly appreciate you having specific ideas as to where your contributions can be published. In addition, all participants should publish at least one article on the Armenian National Platform in English. For this purpose, we offer editing and translation support.

Who can apply?

Journalists from Germany who are interested or already gained some experience in covering war related topics and want to deepen their knowledge in conflict-related journalism. When reviewing applications, we attach great importance to concrete research ideas and implementation.

How to apply?

Until **June 8,2022**, you should please apply with your letter of motivation, a CV and a max. 1-page outline of your research idea. Please also mention some initial ideas where you could publish your article (besides Armenian National Platform). Please submit your application in English.
